

<u>EVS</u>:---

Theme – Family and Friends

- 1. Cut a Tree Trunk out of a brown cardboard. Trace children's hand (one hand per family member). Have children cut the hands out of colourful papers and glue them to the tree trunk. Write the names of the family members on each hand and the relation of the family member with you.
- 2. Make a box containing a variety of objects from around the house (like toothbrush, comb, crayons etc). Children will touch, identify them and write their names on A4 sheet.
- FAMILY MEAL : (Learn family values)
 Observe your mother, how she sets the eating area or table during breakfast, lunch, dinner.

For one day, child can set the table, identify the utensils (forks, knives, spoons, plates etc.) They will make a note of different dishes, and nutrients present in them. Share your one day experience in class. Classify the food items as protective body, building or energy

giving.
